Flexible Deployment and Scheduling

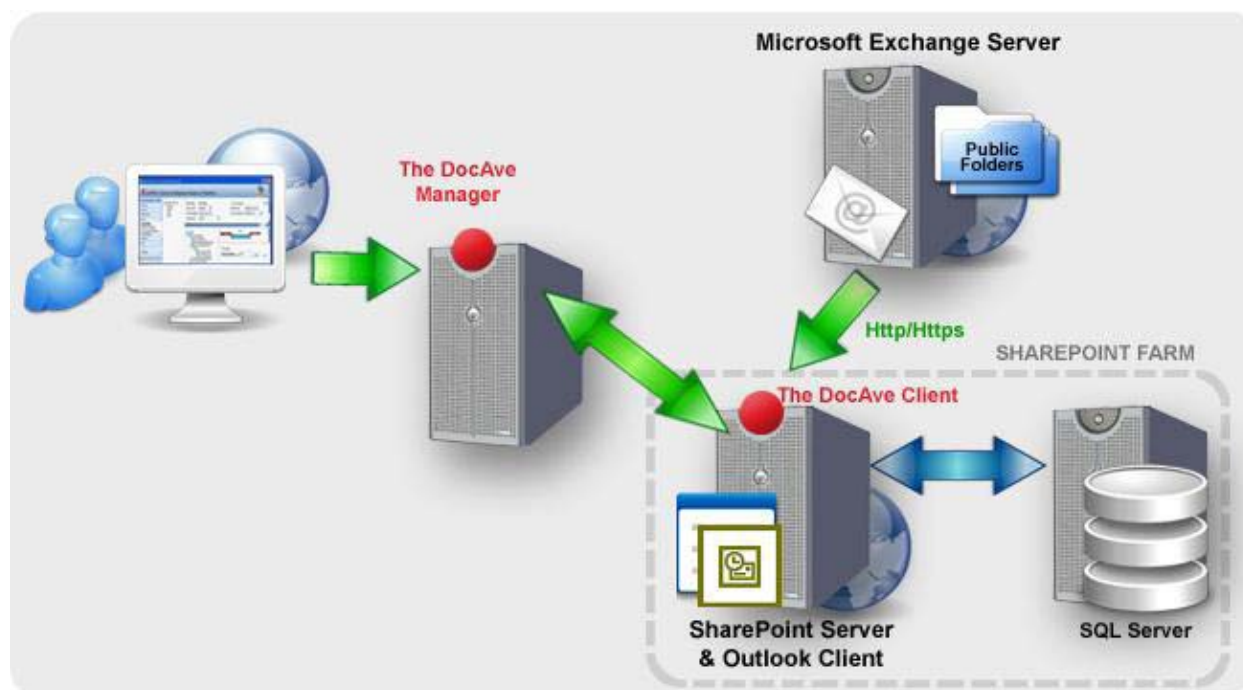
